To all Medieval Campers,

WELCOME TO OUR HUMBLE ESTATE, WHERE FOR THE DURATION OF YOUR STAY WE WILL DO ALMOST ANYTHING TO MAKE IT A HAPPY ONE. BUT FIRST, SOME LAST MINUTE INFORMATION FOR YOU.

HOW TO FIND US.

For those of you who drive it is simple; if you are approaching from the north or south of our fine country on the M1 exit at J23 (NOT J24) follow the signs for Loughborough, when you reach the ring road turn left (you will be following signs then for Derby). Follow the ring road until you connect with the A6. You now need to head north to Derby through Hathern and onto a dual carriageway. Stay in left hand lane as the entrance is approximately 1 mile up on your left. Do NOT come south on the A6 as you will have to travel into Loughborough to turn round because the gap in the middle will be closed)

ON ARRIVAL

On arrival at the site you will be advised where to park your car. To make this easier for the security team please place a piece of card size A5 in the drivers side window showing the colour of the sub camp you are camping on for Medieval this needs to be PURPLE this colour should appear on any kit you have as well. Once you have got your things together make your way to the Medieval Sub Camp.

Your first port of call when you get to the sub camp will depend on when you arrive; for those of you arriving for build week you should report to Abi or Rob who you will find at the OSS compound, located on the Medieval Sub Camp. For those arriving from Friday morning onwards you must report to the Sub Camp HQ which will be located on the right as you enter through the gateway to the Sub Camp. For all members of staff we will be sorting out your car passes and security badges, T shirts and neckerchiefs from 17:00 hrs on Friday evening for 2 hrs. We will open for business from 08:00 Sat morning.

YOU MUST WEAR YOUR SECURITY PASS AT ALL TIMES ONCE YOU HAVE BOOKED IN.

If arriving on Saturday please do not arrive between 10:00 and 15:00 hrs as this will cause major problems as we attempt to get all the campers sorted.

WHAT DO WE HAVE LINED UP FOR YOU

Throughout the week we will have lots of short fun activities for every-one to join in, including quiz's rugby and football mini matches, dwile flunking and possibly quintaining. You can take your temper out on your team leaders by putting them in

the stocks and throwing sponges at them (if the team leaders are game.) if not put your mate in there. We have also been told that staff can use the facilities in the craft tent in the evenings for a small charge. This will include 'T' Shirt designing which you will need to supply your own 'T' shirt for.
