Role Description:	Medical Centre Health Professionals
Role Purpose:	To provide medical service through the provision of participant "Walk In Centre"
Appointed by:	Health & Welfare Team Manager
Responsible to:	Medical centre Team Leader
Responsible for:	First Aid.
Main Contacts:	Camp Management Team, Team Leaders, Internal service providers, Incident Management Team.
External Contacts:	East Midlands Ambulance Service, NHS Walk In Centre, Local GP Clinics

Key Tasks:

- To provide first aid to any participant that requires
- To work a shift rota during the week covering earlies, late and nights at the medical centre.
- To take charge of shifts and support staff with different abilities and backgrounds
- To work with own scope of practice
- To treat injury on site but re-direct to hospital if required
- To attend any meetings where required
- To keep a log of all participants seen and treated.
- Support and respect leaders and staff and assist them with any medical requirements or advice.
- To perform any other tasks deemed necessary by Medical centre team lead.
- Have a clear understanding on the Rules and Standards of Scouting POR and the GirlGuiding Manual, including reporting procedures should an incident occur

- Be assertive to take control of a first aid situation as it arises
