Key Tasks:

- Serving alcohol and soft drinks
- Checking for age of people in the bar
- Ensuring the bar is clean and presentable
- Manage waste and Clearing down after closing and assisting with bar entertainments
- To report for duty on time.
- To ensure that the bar area is kept clean at all times.
- Follow rigidly and observe all hygiene regulations.
- To deal with any customer complaints in a professional manner and to notify management of these.
- To ensure a high standard of personal hygiene.
- To ensure that all reasonable care is taken for the health and safety of yourself, other volunteers, customers and other persons on the premises.
- To observe all safety procedures and rules.
- To ensure that all fire doors are monitored and that fire routes are kept clear at all times.
- Be willing to undergo training where required.
- Be flexible with duties required.
- To contribute to and implement the policies, aims and objectives of the event
- To contribute fully as a member of the Participation Team
- Any other job of a similar or related nature requested by the Camp Directors or CMT
